

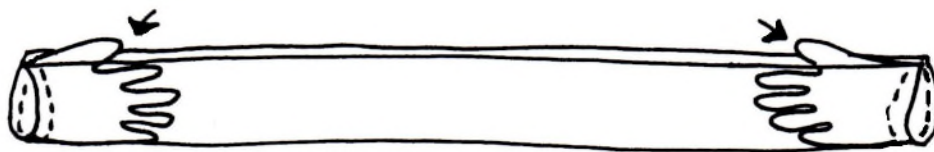
MAKE YOUR OWN YETI HUG SCARF

SUPPLIES

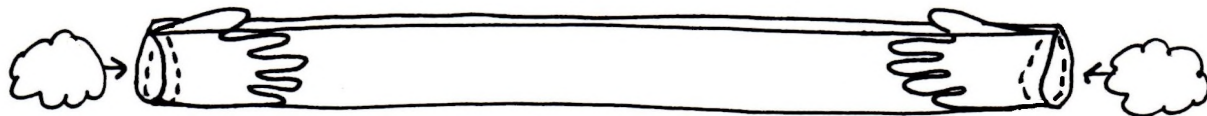
- Piece of white fake fur 5' x 10.5"
- 2 large white velour gloves
- Cotton batting
- Unsharpened pencil or chopstick
- White thread
- Needle

DIRECTIONS

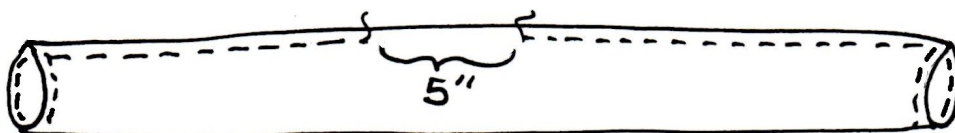
1. With right sides together, machine sew short end of fake fur to cuff of white glove. Then sew the other end to the fake fur to the second glove right sides together, making sure that the thumbs of the gloves align.



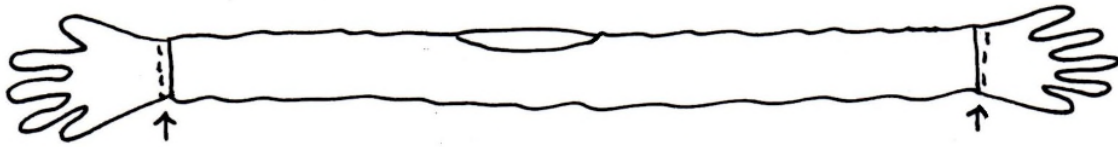
2. Stuff the gloves with the batting, making sure to fill each of the fingers well. You can use a chopstick or the eraser end of a pencil to work the batting into each digit.



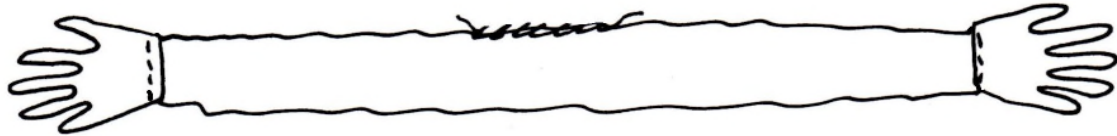
3. With right sides together, sew the long edges of the fake fur together, sewing $\frac{1}{2}$ " from the edge. Be sure to leave an opening of about 5 inches in the middle.



4. Machine stitch the ends of the gloves to keep the batting in place.



5. With needle and thread, hand-stitch the 5 inch opening in the fake fur closed. And now your yeti scarf is done!



To make a hug, wrap the scarf across the front of your neck, cross it in the back, and bring the gloved ends back to your front to meet over your tummy. Interweave the fingers, and you have a yeti hug going on!
